Fire Truck Terms & Condition of Use

The Last Alarm Foundation (LAF) fire truck was designed to help honor deceased firefighters when they answer their "Last Alarm." The fire truck was restored and is operated by volunteers. The non-profit 501C3 corporation strives to fulfill essential duties and requirements of insurance, maintenance and operations solely by donation.

Individuals that request use of the fire truck must understand and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The LAF fire truck is only to be used for funerals that honor firefighters, police, and other public safety personnel.
2. The fire truck will only be used in the State of Arizona.
3. LAF directors and members will make all reasonable efforts to respond to the requests of our public safety brothers and sisters.
4. Use will be determined on a first-come, first-served basis and will be decided in the sole discretion of the Last Alarm Foundation's Board of Directors.
5. The LAF fire truck will not be used for anniversaries of deaths.
6. LAF will provide only the fire truck. Casket, Urn, Pallbearers, Honor Guard, etc. are not provided as part of our service.
7. LAF will not charge a fee for the use of the fire truck or for personnel (the driver or lift operator).
8. All/any use of the truck is subject to the availability of LAF-trained personnel.
9. The LAF fire truck may be used for special events such as parades to honor public safety personnel with at least two weeks notice and will be (a) at the sole discretion of the LAF Board of Directors; (b) subject to availability of the truck on the date requested; and (c) subject to cancellation for any reason, including but not limited to, Section 11 below.
10. The LAF Board will make every effort to respond to funeral requests within 24 hours.
11. Funerals will take precedence for the use of the fire truck over special events. Commitments to special events may have to suddenly be cancelled to accommodate funerals.
12. If the funeral is outside of the Tucson metropolitan area, a transportation fee at the rate of \$0.75/Mile may be required to be paid by the individual or organization requesting the use of the fire truck. (Indicated rate subject to change.)

13. If the fire truck is required to travel overnight, the requesting party will be asked to help coordinate covered storage for the fire truck.
14. If the fire truck is required to travel overnight, the requesting party will be asked to help coordinate sleeping arrangements for personnel at a local fire station. If sleeping arrangements for our volunteers at a fire station is not available, hotel or other acceptable accommodations will need to be provided at the expense of the requesting individual, organization, or fire department.
15. LAF will not be responsible and/or liable for any claim or damages resulting from any unforeseeable delay such as maintenance problems, inclement weather, traffic, or road closures.
16. Vehicle maintenance or emergency flat bedding is the sole responsibility of the LAF.
17. Donations to the LAF in consideration for the use of the vehicle are always appreciated.
18. In consideration for being allowed to use the LAF fire truck the requesting party (i.e. 'client') hereby agrees to release and hold harmless the Last Alarm Foundation, Inc. and any of its officers, employees, or volunteers from any liability and claims arising from its use. Clients agree that they will never prosecute or in any way aid in the prosecution of any demand, claim or suit against LAF, its officers, employees, participating agencies, or volunteers acting officially or otherwise for any loss, damage or injury to person or property that may occur from negligence or use of the truck.
19. At all times, third party/client operation of the truck and truck apparatus is **STRICTY PROHIBITED** by anyone other than LAF personnel (the driver and/or lift operator).
